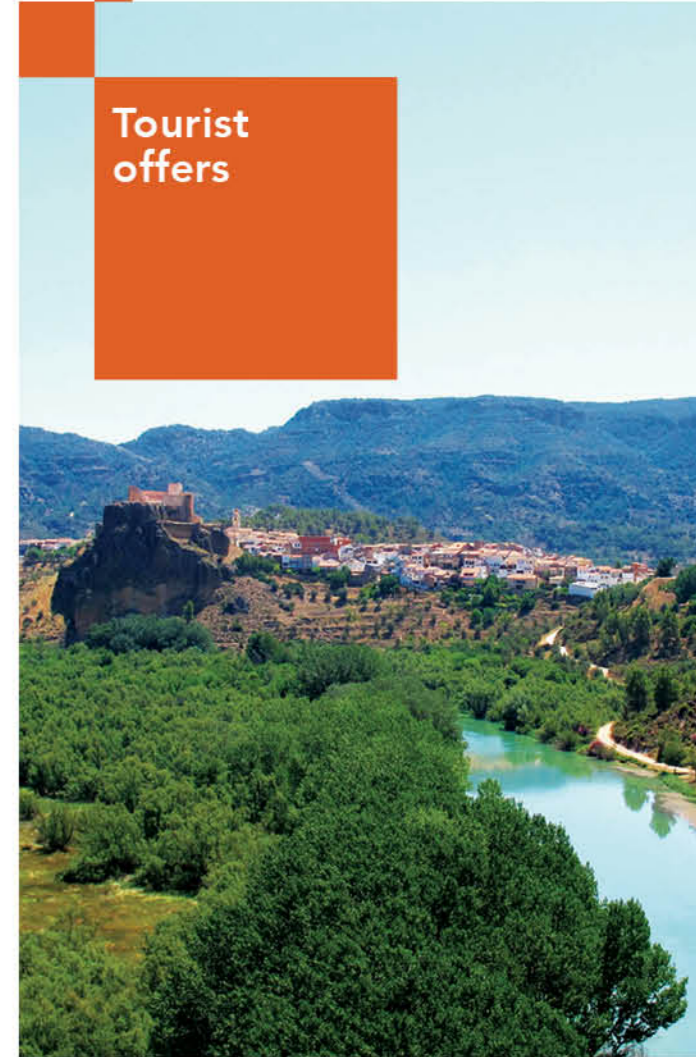

Tourist offers

The ancestry trail invites us to take a walk and discover historical features that best represent the town:

The castle is built on a hearth of basalt rock that originates from the volcano and is surrounded by stone masonry walls. It has served as a fortress and also as a palace and residence. On the Homage Tower you can see one of the oldest clocks in Europe and from the top you can appreciate the stunning panoramic views of the valley. Inside the castle there's a museum that shows a collection of artefacts discovered via archaeological excavations of the mountain, showing remains found from since the mountain was first inhabited.

Daily guided tours are available (Tourist Info Cofrentes (+34) 961894316)

The wonderful nature on offer can be appreciated on various hiking trails. The PR-CV379 trail goes up to the volcano. The PR-CV380 trail allows you to walk along both banks of the Cabriel River. The PR-CV381 wanders between the canyons of the Júcar river and the Sácaras valley. The PR-CV382 trail connects Cofrentes Castle with Chirel Castle.

The river course through the canyons of the Júcar river starts at the Cofrentes pier (about 2 km from the town centre). It runs through 16 km worth of spectacular scenery that is only visible from the water.

The tourist train takes you on different guided routes: one to the Cerro de Agrads Volcano and another route that passes along the river Cabriel.

Located about 4 km from the town centre, the hot springs can be found in a unique natural setting between the mountains, regarded as one of the most important hot spring destinations in all of Spain. Boasting a modern architectural style, they also contain natural medicinal springs recommended for those with digestive, rheumatic, circulatory and respiratory disorders. What's more, thermal circulation, aesthetic treatments, health and wellness treatments are available. Inside the complex there is a pitch and putt golf course with 9 holes. The hot springs are associated with a wellness centre called Confluent Health Resort.

The Cerro de Agrads volcano is the only volcano you can visit in the Valencian community. The unique orography gives you the chance to behold a spectacular panoramic view of the valley from the peak. To get to the volcano you can take the PR-CV-379 trail, or by car take this same path up the mountainside and walk the last one and a half kilometres on foot to reach the top. Cofrentes also offers three leisure sites that include rest areas and recreational facilities. They are equipped with playgrounds and picnic areas and can be found on the Cabriel river, at the pier and in the Campo del Cura (the priest's field).
